

**Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 10-31-099-00 for  
Consulting Services for the Development of an  
Investment Grade Traffic and Revenue Study**

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (Commission) invites Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) from qualified consultants (offerors) to provide professional services associated with the development of an investment grade traffic and revenue study, including performance of the proposed tasks and provision of the deliverables identified in the above-referenced RFQ, as well as other work elements recommended by the offeror to support Commission toll revenue bond issuance.

It is the Commission's intent that all firms obtain the full content of this RFQ and all addenda via the Commission's website located at [www.rctc.org/rfps.asp](http://www.rctc.org/rfps.asp). Please note that the Commission will ***not*** be responsible for mailing any addenda to prospective offerors. Each offeror will be responsible for downloading the RFQ and all related addenda, so offerors are encouraged to check the website regularly.

Except for Greg Moore, the Commission's Procurement and Assets Manager, no contact of any kind regarding this RFQ shall be made with any of the Commission's board members or the Commission's staff, including the Commission's program management consultant, Bechtel Infrastructure Corporation, or other members of the project delivery team. It is intended that the consultant selection shall be made on merit alone within the process described in the RFQ. Violation of this condition may result in immediate disqualification of an offeror's SOQ.

All questions and requests for clarification related to the RFQ must be in writing and received by the Commission prior to **May 24, 2010**, 2:00 pm.

SOQ submittals are due no later than 2:00 p.m. on **June 3, 2010**. They should be submitted to the attention of Greg Moore, Procurement and Assets Manager, at the Commission's offices, 4080 Lemon Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Riverside, CA 92501.

SOQs received after the date and time specified above will be returned to the offeror unopened. Faxed or electronically submitted SOQs will not be accepted.
