### **New Transit Center to Open In Perris**

#### **Event Information**

Transit riders can now look forward to utilizing a brand new transit center in the heart of Downtown Perris. The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) in cooperation with the Riverside Transit Agency (RTA) and the city of Perris are holding a ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the opening of Riverside County's newest transit center.

This event commemorates the first phase of what will eventually grow into a major multimodal center served by more than 200 buses serving seven bus routes. The \$5 million facility features eight bus bays and a 141-space Park and Ride Lot. Another added feature includes an artwork theme inspired by renowned animator Ward Kimball who created a number of Disney's classic characters. Within a few years, the Perris Station Transit Center will also be home to a Metrolink commuter rail stop on the planned Perris Valley Line.
