

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE





Nightly eastbound and westbound alternating lane closures, Express Lanes closures, ramp closures, and connector closures are scheduled the week of July 1, 2024.

Construction details below. Construction activity and closure schedules are subject to change.

In observance of the Fourth of July, no closures will take place from Wednesday morning, July 3 through Monday morning, July 7.

RCTC Traffic Relief Plan



Approved by the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) on April 10, 2024, the Traffic Relief Plan outlines aspirational transportation solutions in Riverside County for Riverside County residents.

The updated Plan identifies the need to invest in crucial transportation projects, services, and infrastructure, including public transportation, roadway safety, highway improvements, active transportation, securing infrastructure from natural disasters, and environmental mitigation.
