

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Week of September 2, 2024



Nightly alternating lane closures of eastbound 91 and southbound 71, connector closures, and ramp closures are scheduled for the week of September 2, 2024.

Please see closure details below. Construction activity and closure schedules are subject to change.

In observance of the Labor Day holiday, no closures will take place from Friday, August 30 to Tuesday, September 3.

Upcoming Northbound 71 Connector Closures

A nighttime full closure of the eastbound and westbound 91 to northbound 71 connectors are scheduled for **Friday, September 6.** Motorists traveling to destinations along the 71 such as Chino, Chino Hills, and Pomona are encouraged to use alternate routes and avoid the 71/91 interchange.
